Former Sheridan High School facility is set into memory but it has played several roles over the lifetime of the community.

The buildings have served as a high school and an elementary facility, but it is now in transition to become affordable housing developed by WODA Cooper Companies. Since 1990, they have created more than 20,000 housing units in rural, suburban and urban settings across 15 state.

The former Sheridan High School will have one, two or three bedrooms units and the adapted gymnasium will be available for rent for youth basketball and other multi-purpose uses. Woda was formed in 1990 with offices in Indianapolis and headquarters in Columbus, OH.

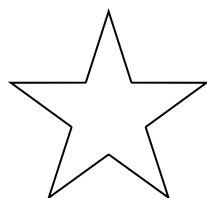

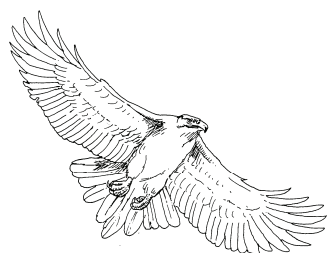
